Dear Parents, Guardians, Teachers, Staff, and Crawford Tech Family:

Crawford Tech has always placed great importance on the safety and wellbeing of our students, your sons and daughters, and our staff, while providing them with real-life technical job-related opportunities.

Around February 20, 2026, Crawford Tech became aware of events that occurred outside of the campus. On that date, Crawford Tech received notification from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection concerning work that occurred at the former Integrity Auto building located at 20763 Old Ellis Hill Road, Meadville, PA 16335, stating that there was potential exposure to asbestos due to remedial work being done on the building around February 9, 10, 18 and 20th.

Since that period, we have contacted all those individuals that we believe have been potentially exposed, or affected, by phone. **If you have not been contacted by phone as of the date of this letter, we do not believe you or your child has been affected.**


Immediately after Crawford Tech became aware of these events, it began partnering with several organizations and professionals to make sure your students and our staff were safe.

First and foremost, the old Integrity Auto Building was secured. Crawford Tech then partnered with environmental professionals that were recommended by the DEP to analyze the potential exposure. We are continuing to actively work with those environmental professionals to provide reports of the potential exposure and will follow up once those results are finalized and received. Out of an abundance of caution, we also are working with the environmental professionals to identify and prevent any potential secondary exposure to asbestos both inside and outside of Crawford Tech. Second, we have been in contact with medical professionals to provide access to testing to those who may have been potentially affected. Third, we are working with community leaders and occupational educational leaders to provide access to information and materials to educate you and your students about real world occupational hazards that individuals face every day in their respective fields.

Crawford Tech has always strived to steward your students' time at our institution with great care and will continue to make safety, as well as education, our top priority. Crawford Tech remains committed to protecting your students and our staff to whom we provide services.
