**RE:** Items needed to start class in the fall

As a student in the Diesel Technology Shop at the Crawford County Career & Technical Center (CCCTC), there are some items that you will need to purchase during the summer for class this fall. Please have these items before the first day of class on **Wednesday, September 2, 2020.**

1. **Heavy Leather (over the ankle) Work boots:** (steel toes preferred). Tennis shoes or leisure type shoes will **NOT** be permitted in the shop during classtime.
2. **Work Uniforms:** Students must acquire suitable work clothing, such as uniform type pants and shirt or coveralls. Cleanliness it is the responsibility of the student and is also part of their daily grade. Uniforms **must** be kept clean, so we recommend that several sets of uniforms be purchased.
3. Although not required, these items may be useful: pocket screwdriver; pocket flashlight; pocket magnet/magnetic screw holder; small tape measure (6'), clip on or pocket size; pocket/telescoping mirror and a tire tread depth gauge.
4. **3-Ring Notebook:** Large 3" ring binder.
5. **Safety Glasses:** The school will provide one pair of non-prescription glasses to first year students. If you wear prescription glasses, they **MUST** be ANSI Z87.1 approved safety lenses with side shields, which can be purchased through your eye care provider.

If you feel that the above mentioned costs may be a deterrent to your son's/daughter's enrolling at the Crawford County Career & Technical Center, please notify your home school guidance counselor or Student Services at CCCTC to discuss financial alternatives.
